Ways of optimizing your search results:

Boolean operators

To retrieve information using combinations of search terms:

AND

Results will contain ALL of the search terms.

Travel AND Europe

OR

Each result will contain at least **ONE** of the search terms.

College **OR** university

NOT

NONE of the results will contain the **SECOND** search term.


