

Ten-point plan of action for contributing to the internationalization of scientific journals

- 1. Preferably use **English as the language of publication** and management, taking into account that it is currently the lingua franca for science.
- 2. Highlight publication of the journal in **open access** in the sense of providing free access to scientific production worldwide.
- 3. Set out a strategy linked to the **areas of expertise of the directors** of the journal that enables a connection with the international scientific community.
- 4. Clearly establish the **aim and scope of the journal**, including the international impact it might have.
- 5. Look for **international partnerships** for co-publishing and academic co-leadership.
- 6. Include **members of international relevance on the editorial boards** in line with the quality standards of scientific publications.
- 7. Promote calls for papers and single-subject issues with co-publishers from different countries and subject areas with an international scope.
- Locate international experts according to the subject area of the article to conduct reviews and be sure to assign the review of articles to academics in other countries.
- Show with transparency the data and time of the journal's activity and the advantages of publishing in it with the aim of attracting international and quality authors.
- 10. Facilitate the dissemination of the journal's contents on social and academic media (in-house or external).
