
# The UOC's transformative agreements

# What are they? ☑

They are **agreements between publishers and research institutions** designed to foster open science. Thanks to these agreements, the UOC has **credits and discounts** available to cover the fees (known as article processing charges or APCs) charged by the major publishing groups for open-access publication in some of their journals.



## With which publishers do we have agreements?

We currently have agreements with Elsevier, Springer Nature, Wiley, Emerald and IEEE.





There are also discounts for publishing with Frontiers, MDPI and Bentham Science.

### The following requirements must be met

Be the article's lead or corresponding author

Have an ORCID iD


Have an active profile on the UOC's Researchers' Portal (GIR)

Belong to the UOC at the time the article is accepted

# How are they requested? ☑

Submit the article to the chosen journal as usual and make sure that you meet the above requirements.

The **Open Science** team will manage the request and let you know if you can use one of the available credits.



If you can, don't forget to deposit a copy of the publication in the **UOC's institutional repository, O2**
